

2024 TULIP FESTIVAL FIELD TRIPS

Yule Forest is celebrating the miracle of the spring for visitors of all ages to come and enjoy at our farm. Our seasonal field trips provide the perfect opportunity for students to learn and engage in an outdoor environment at our farm. We welcome you to book your groups for this unique and fun trip to Yule Forest and our Tulip Festival.

- **HAYRIDE:** All-aboard our tractor hayride for a fantastic trip around our farm and fields.
- **FUN ZONE:** Bouncy Houses, Slides, Sportsplex, and other outdoor games and activities. (Minimum play time of 20 min.)
- **FLOWER FIELDS:** Let the students enjoy a walk through the tulip and flower fields and get as many pictures as you can take.
- PLANTING STATION: Each student, parent, teacher, and sibling will receive a mystery bulb, reusable cup, and plant their tulip while learning about what it takes to grow a plant. Keep them in the classroom to see them grow!
- **ADD TO THE FLOWER WALL:** Before arriving at the Farm, have each student decorate their own Tulip and place it on our wall at the farm. (Will be sent a week before arriving).
- FARM FRIENDS: Get to experience the Farm animals up close and have the opportunity to pet them.
- **DISCOVERY ZONE:** Discover how farming has evolved over time and learn how the Netherlands used windmills to power their farming industry.
- **FLOWER CANNON:** Teachers will test their skills to win a prize.
- **STORY TIME:** Sit down and listen to our Gardener read a fun story about spring time on the Farm.
- TULIPMANIA MOVIE: Learn the history of the Tulip flower and see what Tulipmania is all about.
- PICNIC AREA FOR LUNCHES: Students can enjoy their brought lunch at our outdoor picnic area.
- ONLINE EDUCATION PACKET: Age-appropriate fun Spring learning activities already organized for the teacher that can be downloaded.

SCHOOL AND DAYCARE RESERVATIONS

- To reserve your spot a non-refundable, deposit needs to be paid within seven days of booking.
 - \$50 deposit for all groups.
- A Square payment processing invoice will be sent to the contact email provided at booking. If the balance is
 not paid within the seven days, then we will assign your date and time to a class on our waiting list. No
 exceptions.
- When booking your groups, you'll be required to list the estimated number of students attending. The final count of students will need to be given on the day of your field trip. You will not be charged for students that did not attend.
- The complete payment for students will be due on the day of your field trip. Card payment methods are preferred; however, we do accept checks.
- Chaperones are responsible for paying for themselves on the day of the field trip, do not include them in your final count of students.
- The Monday before your field trip you will receive an email to download the applicable Education Packets to get your students excited for their upcoming adventure to Yule Forest.
- If we have to cancel your field trip due to inclement weather or other unplanned circumstances, we will try to provide you with a day to reschedule if possible or we will issue a refund of your deposit.

HOMESCHOOL DAY ATTENDANCE

- There is no reservation required for our Homeschool Day on Friday, March 8th from 10:00 am 1:00 pm.
- Admission fee is \$12 per person.

- Field trips are available Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday between March 12th 21st.
- Available bookings are for 10:00 am and 11:00 pm time slots
- Friday, March 8, 2024 from 10:00 am 1:00 pm is reserved for homeschool students only.

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- This is a guided field trip tour setup as "stations", so we can rotate groups between each one.
- Each field trip will last between 1 2 hours. We do not have an option to stay longer after your alotted time; however, we would love for students and their families to come and visit us on the weekends for the Pumpkin Patch.
- We ask for your group to arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled time to allow for the check-in process. If
 you arrive late for your tour, the allotted time for the Fun Zone activity will be reduced to keep the schedule
 on track.
- We cannot wait on parents or other guests of your group to arrive for your field trip to begin. Everyone must be together and ready to begin at your booked time.
- Parents and other guests attending your field trip do not pay their admission cost with the school reservation. They will pay individually when they arrive on the day of the field trip.
- All remaining groups and guests must be leaving the property by 12:30 pm so our staff can reset for the following day and we can resume our regular farming activities.
- Visitors in wheelchairs will experience traveling across some gravel. Each activity and exhibit area is accessible during the tour to wheelchairs; however, assistance will likely be required over some terrain.

Sharing the joy of farming and giving children the opportunity to learn through hands-on experiences, is what motivates us to provide field trips. We look forward to you joining us this fall.
